Subject: Amendment #17 Administrative Modification to the 2011 Federal Statewide  
Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP)

Dear Muhaned:

This letter is to notify you that the Shasta County Regional Transportation Planning Agency (SCRTPA) has approved Administrative Modification #17 to the 2010 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) and the 2011 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). The changes are as follows:

- **Social Services Transit Vehicles and Equipment (211-0000-0061):** the following local agencies were awarded 5316 (JARC) and 5317 (New Freedom) funds in the 5316/5317 grant cycle six. Each project was awarded 50% federal funds with a 50% toll credit match. All funds are programmed in FY 12/13, with a total project cost increase of \$136,577 or 5.8%.
  - Golden Umbrella: two Golden Umbrella volunteer driver programs received operating assistance; the Senior Companions program provides transportation assistance to low-income seniors with disabilities (a total of \$22,495), and the Foster Grandparent program provides reimbursement for volunteer drivers (a total of \$53,400).
  - Shasta Senior Nutrition Programs: new fund source added (New Freedom Projects 5317), programs a total of \$60,682 for operating assistance of a feeder transit service for the disabled in rural Shingletown, Palo Cedro and Millville.

This programming change is consistent with Caltrans' procedures for FSTIP/FTIP modifications and does not affect any outstanding amendments. With the delegation of authority to approve FSTIP Administrative Modifications granted on January 9, 2012, the SCRTPA approves FTIP/FSTIP Administrative Modification #17.

Amendment #17 to the 2011 FSTIP

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This approved FTIP/FSTIP Administrative Modification #17 is being provided to Caltrans, the FHWA, the FTA, grant recipients in Shasta County, and is posted on the SCRTPA website. Caltrans will post the approved administrative modification on the Division of Transportation Programming website.
