## Amendment #1

### Infill & Redevelopment Incentive Program, Cycle II, Request for Proposals

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In accordance with the SRTA's Request for Proposals (RFP), issued April 27, 2017, for Projects Located in the Downtown Redding Strategic Growth Area, all changes to the RFP shall be made by written addenda, posted online, and shall be considered part of the RFP.

SRTA hereby enacts the following two changes:

**1) Proposal Evaluation Criteria, from Page 8 of the RFP:**

| Proposal Evaluation Criteria  | Points |

| Thoroughness of proposal in meeting the objectives of this RFP and local and regional plans   | 20     |
| Degree to which project addresses AHSC program objectives   | 20     |
| Project support, as demonstrated by letters of support and documentation of community collaboration toward the project concept, <b>or documented history of community collaboration and letters of support associated with similar type projects.</b> | 20     |
| Ability to deliver the project if awarded an AHSC grant, as demonstrated by financial capacity and experience delivering similar projects   | 20     |
| Matching funds (cash and in-kind)   | 20     |
| Total Points  | 100    |

Reason for the change: It has come to SRTA's attention that community organizations were unsure of which project proposal to support and whether or not they could support more than one project. The purpose of the 'project support' evaluation factor was to encourage community collaboration toward the project, not to put community organizations in the position of choosing to support one proposal over another. SRTA continues to encourage community organizations and stakeholders to provide letters of support, including letters on behalf of more than one project proposal. In addition, SRTA welcomes letters of support and documented history of community collaboration associated with other projects located inside or outside of the Shasta Region.

**2) Proposal deadline extension:**

To allow proposers adequate time to respond to the above change, the deadline to submit proposals has been extended one week to **June 7, 2017**.
