**SUBJECT: FY 2018/19 Regional Non-Motorized Program  
Notice of Funding Availability and Grant Application Guidelines**

---

The Shasta Regional Transportation Agency (SRTA) is pleased to announce the availability of Regional Non-Motorized Program funding. In addition to funding projected to be available for FY 2018/19 (about \$734,000), SRTA is interested in dedicating funding from future cycles (up to a double current program budget) for ambitious projects that strive to meet regional priorities. Depending on the number, readiness, and quality of applications, the SRTA Board of Directors may award less than the full budgeted amount or award funding to projects in phases.

The purpose of the program is to implement the GoShasta Regional Active Transportation Program adopted by the SRTA Board of Directors February 2018, and support the realization of performance outcomes in the Regional Transportation Plan and Sustainable Communities Strategy (RTP/SCS) for mode shift and reduced per capita vehicle miles traveled and greenhouse gas emissions. The final report is available online at <http://www.srta.ca.gov/286/GoShasta>.

Eligible activities include:

- Bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure;
- Bicycle and pedestrian amenities; and
- Programs that promote the use and safety of bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure and amenities.

As described in the attached guidelines, formal applications have been replaced with a consultation process with SRTA staff as well as community stakeholders representing the interests of bicyclists and pedestrian and public transportation.

Deadline to submit all materials for funding consideration at the October 9, 2018, SRTA Board of Directors meeting is **September 12, 2018**. Projects needing additional time to develop may be prepared for consideration at a future scheduled meeting date.
